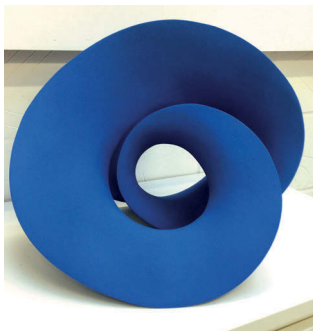

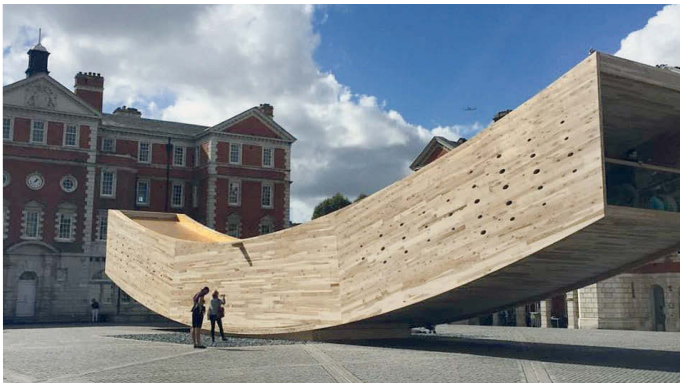

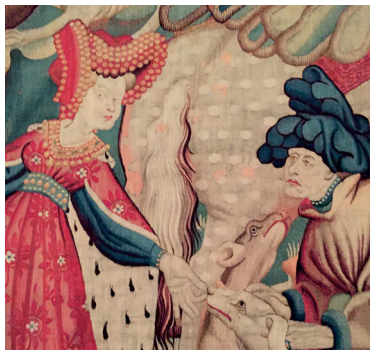

A SELECTION OF TOURS

Here you'll find a selection of my most popular tours.

1 The New London Skyline

In this exciting tour, you'll see the capital's tallest, most inspiring and luxurious buildings, including the 'Shard', the 'Cheesegrater' and the 'Walkie-Scorchie' as well as the major developments taking place in and around Canary Wharf. This tour can be made by boat and cable car, offering marvellous views of the new skyline.

2 20th Century Scandinavian Design V&A

Scandinavian design has been described as the most important design movement since WWII. Discover the story behind modern design icons, such as Alvar Aalto's Savoy vase, the Verner Panton chair and Arne Jacobsen's 3107 chair, made famous by Christine Keeler.

3 The Wallace Collection

Described as the 'hidden jewel' of London's art galleries, The Wallace Collection is a gloriously eclectic collection built up by five generations of the Marquesses of Hertford. Renowned for its 18th century French art, highlights include wonderful Sèvres porcelain and works by French painters François Boucher and Jean-Honoré Fragonard.

4 National Portrait Gallery

Embark on a journey of British history through portraits, starting with the Ditchley portrait of Queen Elizabeth I and ending with work by contemporary artists such as Marc Quinn and Sam Taylor-Johnson. Learn about great British personalities and how portraiture has changed over the times.

5 The Exquisite Lines of Oriental Art V&A

Explore the treasures of Oriental art and design, including exquisitely dyed and embroidered silk kimonos, the charming and intricate work found on netsuke and inro, and the Mazarin Chest - the V&A's most important lacquer treasure, made with incredible technique and skill.

6 The Elegance of Islamic Decorative Art V&A

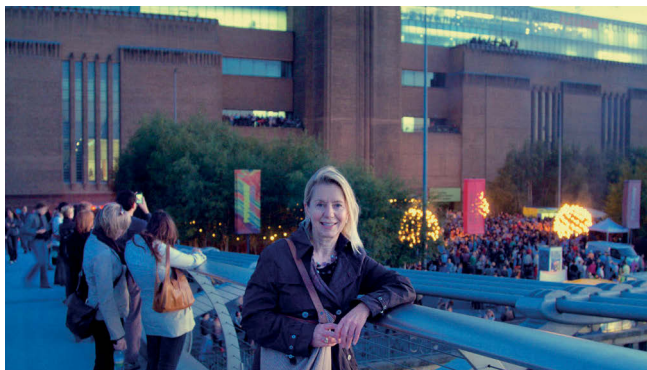
Exploring religious and secular Islamic art, this tour of the Jameel Gallery looks at court art such as a fabulous 1000-year-old rock crystal ewer and elegant 16th century Iznik ceramics. The tour culminates in the British Galleries, where we consider the influence of Islamic art on William Morris and the V&A itself.

7 Westminster Abbey

Steeped in thousands of years of history, this majestic abbey is one of the jewels of English architecture. Walk by the tombs of Queen Elizabeth I and Mary Queen of Scots, see the famous Poets' Corner and marvel at the exquisite 13th century Cosmati pavement - a few highlights from this must-see tour.
